grow up to be a great man. People everywhere will love him.



The Cast





Shepherd Scene



- **Shepherd 1** Come, let us lie down and sleep awhile.


- Child 1You could pretend that these flowers are from all of us.






Children's Scene




Narrator 5 And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said one to another, Let us now go even unto
